Visitor Statistics

I attach our latest visitor numbers, visitors and profits were down slightly in January compared to 2024, in February visitors were down but profits up slightly.

We have had a very strong couple of months for ticket sales with Johnny Cowling (a Town Council event) and Plymouth Symphony Orchestra both selling out around 6 weeks before the performances. The Menheniot panto was also really popular. Ticket sales are up 156% on last year and we currently have tickets available for East Cornwall Bach Choir's singing day this coming weekend and Kate Rogers Academy's production of Aladdin Jr next month.
