

A390 Bridge repair project • February 2025

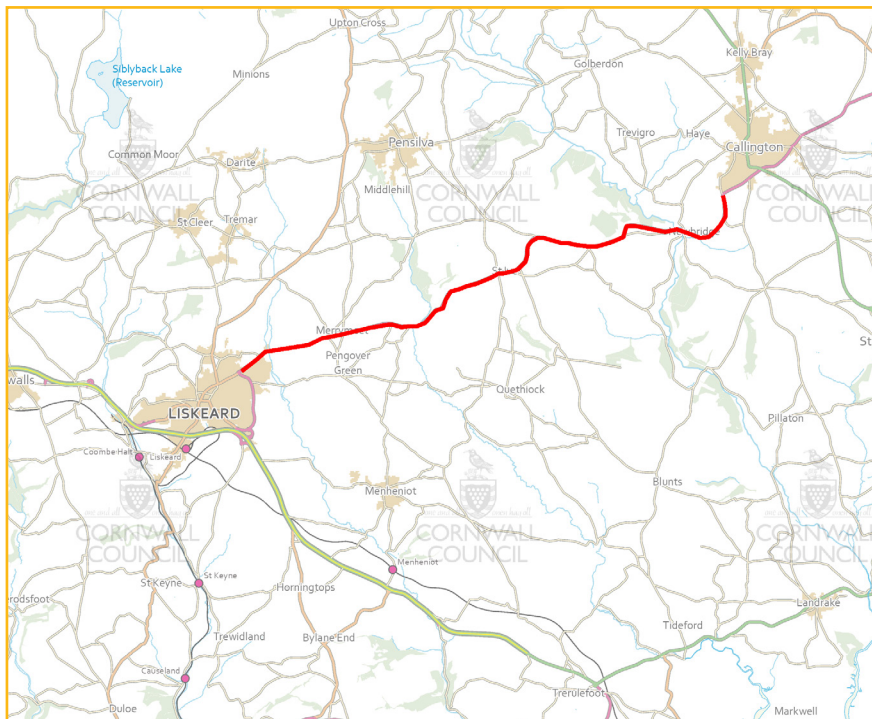
Newbridge, Callington

We will begin essential repairs to the bridge in Newbridge on Monday 17 February. To complete these repairs, we will need to implement a 24-hour closure of the A390 for one week.

This closure is necessary as we will be installing scaffolding around the bridge to ensure a safe working environment for our team. The scaffolding will be in place throughout the week, which will significantly narrow the road and prevent vehicle access across the bridge entirely. As a result, road users will not be able to access Callington via the A390 during this time.

The project has been scheduled during the half-term break to reduce disruption to the school bus services. The bus companies are aware of the road closure and will be making alternative arrangements where necessary.

We understand that this closure may cause inconvenience, and we appreciate everyone's understanding and cooperation as we work to carry out these important repairs.

What works are taking place?

Work includes repairs to the bridge including parapet replacements. This project is crucial for maintaining the safety and integrity of the bridge.

Diversion

Signs will be placed at major junctions prior to the road closure on the key routes.

We understand that diversion routes can sometimes be lengthy. However, it is important that these routes are suitable for the types of vehicles that would normally use them.

Remember, these diversions are in place to ensure your safety and that of other road users. All instructions and signage must be followed.
